## PROGRAMS

The College's ever-expanding choice of pathways now includes:

- 87 diploma programs
- 27 graduate programs
- 12 Bachelor's degrees
- 18 certificate programs
- Joint programs with York University, University of Toronto and Trent University

In addition, Seneca has more than 240 individual degree pathways for graduates at 62 partner institutions in Canada and around the world.

The College also offers newcomer bridging with training and re-employment services for internationally trained professionals as well as academic upgrading for college eligibility.

These diverse options allow Seneca to achieve its overall mission to provide accessibility to quality programs, services and experiences that ensure students are career-ready upon graduation.

## ENROLMENT

The 905 area, which includes York Region, will be the fastest growing area in Ontario from 2007 to 2021. Seneca's full-time enrollment numbers reflect this trend, with a more than 14 per cent increase between 2008 and 2010.

In its 42-year history, it is estimated that more than 1 million people have pursued learning at Seneca.

Seneca has plans to expand in order to meet student demand over the next 10 years and beyond. In June 2011, it was announced that Seneca will receive \$43 million from the provincial government to revitalize current buildings and expand community safety and health services training at its King City campus while creating classroom space for an additional 1,450 students. There is also potential for further growth at Seneca's Markham campus.
